AEPS is an international cutting-edge Master's Degree program. Students will become experts in applying psychological knowledge and techniques in the public and the private sector, including academics.

Duration: 2 years.

Number of enrolled students: 60

The program consists of two main core domains: (1) state-of-the-art topics in applied psychological sciences; (2) methodology and research skills.

The first year is designed to provide common solid advanced theoretical knowledge of a range of different psychological science domains as well as on the main research methods. used in these domains.

The second year offers a more specific focus on the application in specific domains through the combination of a choice of elective courses among a set of relevant options, an internship and the dissertation. During this second year, the laboratory activities will be devoted to research and intervention planning.

The programme is delivered through a combination of:

- Research-informed lectures, including guest speakers;
- Students' preparation of assignments and presentations, group work, discussions, analysis of cutting-edge literature;
- Laboratory activities on programming languages (e.g., E-Prime, Inquisit, Matlab, R):
- Laboratory activities on research methods;
- Laboratory activities devoted to planning and writing research and intervention projects;
- Research (internal) or professional (external) internships:
- Collaborations on research activities.






- Analyse cognitive, behavioural, and decision-making processes at the individual, organisational, and policy-making levels;

- Plan effective interventions, aimed at modifying behaviours in socially relevant domains (e.g., health sectors, environmental, political participation);
- Suggest and promote institutional changes (e.g., in schools), aimed at promoting well-being and adequate cognitive and behavioural processes:
- Work in public institutions, foundations, non-profit sectors, national and international sectors:
- Work in private companies, consulting firms, communication agencies, national and international sectors;
- Work in national and international market research companies.

In order to apply, students must have acquired certified competence within the scientific domains specified in the call for application and must have certified B2 (or superior) English language proficiency.


